Technical requirements

Before accessing **Eni eBusiness** Services: (Marketplace, e-Sourcing / e-Contest, P&CM, Eni Fuel e-bidding, Versalis e-bidding, Gela Refinery e-bidding, Press Center, P2P Eni US) you need to verify that your Internet connections are compatible.

It is advisable to operate from a workstation equipped with the technical requirements listed below.

Minimum hardware requirements

- CPU: Pentium or higher.

Minimum requirements for Internet connection

- Access to Eni's e-Business service via browser via Internet Service Provider. An ADSL or higher connection is recommended.

Browser requirements

- To use the Eni e-Business service correctly, it is essential to use one of the following browsers:
 - **Microsoft Edge**
 - **Google Chrome**
 - **Mozilla Firefox – Firefox Extended Support Release**
- Following the latest updates to the Chromium engine, a parameterization has been introduced in the Google Chrome and Microsoft Edge browsers which inhibits normal navigation within the pages. On the most recent versions of these browsers, it is therefore necessary to act as described below.
 - **Browser Microsoft Edge:**
 1. Enter the following link into your browser's address bar:
`edge://flags/#origin-agent-cluster-default`



2. Set "Disabled" instead of "Default" under "Origin-keyed Agent Clusters by default"
3. Restart your browser
