



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)
FOR INTEGRATED ONSHORE LOGISTIC BASE – EPC AND O&M CONTRACT
PEMBA – MOZAMBIQUE

Eni Rovuma Basin B.V. – Mozambique Branch (hereinafter referred to as “Company”), acting on behalf of the Area 4 Partners, invites qualified local and international companies to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for participation in a potential tender process for the development and operation of an Integrated Onshore Logistic Base (IOLB) located in Pemba, Mozambique.

The envisaged project may include the detailed engineering of the proposed solution, the provision of land (preliminary estimated area of 10–15 hectares), the construction and operation of logistics and support facilities, including but not limited to accommodation, warehousing, logistic services, catering, and open storage areas.

1. Selection Process

The EOI aims to identify companies with adequate:

- Legal standing and organizational capability;
- Financial capacity;
- Demonstrated technical expertise;

in engineering, procurement, construction and operation of integrated logistics bases and associated infrastructure.

Interested companies shall demonstrate proven experience across the full project lifecycle (i.e., design, construction, and operations) of similar assets.

Submission of an EOI does not guarantee participation in subsequent phases. Only shortlisted companies may be invited to participate in further qualification and tender processes

2. Scope of Work (Indicative)

The anticipated Scope of Work may include, but is not limited to, the following elements which may be adjusted during subsequent tender phases:

A. Engineering and Development

- Development of an engineered proposal based on Company-provided design basis
- Project management, engineering, procurement, construction, and commissioning activities

B. Land Provision

- Availability to develop the initiative in Pemba on a land identified by Company taking into account the Resolução 6/2024, de 30 de Agosto, publicada no Boletim da República N. 170 III Serie, or
- Availability to provide a suitable land area (approximately 10–15 hectares) in Pemba
- The proposed location shall ensure efficient logistics operations; proximity to operational quays will be considered a key evaluation parameter

C. Infrastructure Development

- Full site development and civil works including but not limited to:
 - Warehouses, laydown areas, and workshops;
 - Accommodation camp and catering facilities;
 - Open storage areas and specialized facilities (e.g., chemical or temperature-controlled storage, if applicable).
- Provision of all required utilities, including but not limited to power, water, wastewater management, telecommunications, firefighting, and security systems

D. Operations and Maintenance Services

- Operations and maintenance of the logistics base inclusive of the accommodation areas
- Facility management
- Management of camp operations, including facility upkeep, cleaning, waste management, and pest control

E. Provision of supporting services including accommodation and catering

- Operation, and maintenance of accommodation facilities supporting Company and Contractors' personnel, including but not limited to lodgings, catering, housekeeping, laundry, and welfare services
- Catering services to be delivered in accordance with applicable international standards for food safety, hygiene, and nutrition

F. Integrated Logistic services (Optional)

Provision of integrated logistics services to support offshore and onshore operations, which may include:

- Receipt, handling, storage, and dispatch of materials and equipment
- Warehouse management, inventory control, and material tracking systems
- Coordination of inbound and outbound transportation, including interface with port, customs brokers, and freight forwarders
- Management of laydown areas and specialized storage (e.g. hazardous materials, chemicals, temperature-controlled goods)
- Implementation of systems and procedures ensuring full traceability, inventory accuracy, and compliance with Company material management requirements
- Provision of qualified personnel, equipment, and management systems necessary to deliver logistics services in line with industry's best practices

This scope is considered optional and may be included in whole or in part in subsequent tender phases or structured as a separate contract lot

3. Documentation Requirements

Interested vendors must submit the following documents through the link provided below as minimum requirements.

I. Technical Documentation

- a) A formal Expression of Interest letter confirming willingness to participate in early engagement for the development of the Integrated Onshore Logistic Base (IOLB) and readiness to join a competitive tender in 2026, considering the following:
 - **Phase 1:** target completion of a first stage of construction activities of approximately 2-4 hectares inclusive of open storage area, chemical storage, covered warehouse and temperature controlled room by 2027 with starting of the associated services to be provided by the same year.
 - **Phase 2:** development of the rest of the facilities inclusive of additional open storage area, covered warehouses and accommodation facilities to cover the full area of 10-15 hectares within 2028 with starting of the associated services to be provided by the same year.

- b) Verified track record of similar projects executed in the last 10 years as main contractor and/or main subcontractor for engineering/construction/operations and maintenance of all the areas defined in the Scope of Work.
- c) Description of proposed land solution, including provision of the DUAT (Direito do Uso e Aproveitamento de Terra) for the proposed IOLB; in case the DUAT is not under vendor's name, to provide the agreement with the ultimate owner of the DUAT;
- d) Evidence of the distance and logistics connectivity between proposed site and available quays in Pemba;
- e) Identification of the Execution Strategy with an estimated timeline to start construction activities.
- f) Evidence of HSE policies and performance data for the last three years, including Total Recordable Incidents Rate (TRIR);
- g) Evidence of Quality Management System certifications proving compliance with international Quality Standards (e.g. ISO 9001:2008 / 2015);
- h) Evidence of valid Health, Safety and Environment Management System documents and certifications proving compliance with international standards (ISO 45001 and ISO 14001);

II. Administrative Documentation

- i) Scanned certified copy of the Trade Register, Legal Entity name and contact person for receiving qualification package and other relevant information from the **Eni Rovuma Basin B.V.**;
- j) Last three years Financial Statements and Annual Report including Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss and Cash Flow Statement with a average turnover of at least 20 Million Dollars. These documents must be provided for the Company/JV/Consortium entering into the Contract as well as their own parent companies (if applicable), and also for the Company's Mozambican registered entity that will enter into the subject contract;
- k) Company's registration in Mozambique. In case your Company is not already registered in Mozambique, please specify if you would be willing to promptly register in Mozambique and specify the respective timeline;
- l) Company and Group Structure with the list of major Shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in the stock exchange);
- m) In case you wish to participate in the Expression of Interest as a consortium or as a joint venture, information about each member of consortium or joint venture and role of each participant in the potential project. Such intention

to form either a consortium or a JV, must be supported by an Agreement or “Memorandum of Understanding” duly signed by each entity in the group.

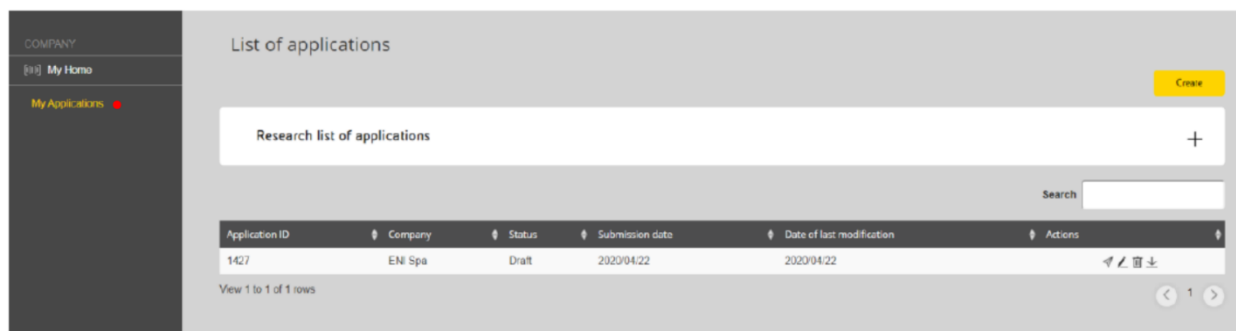
4. Submission Method
