



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

FOR PROVISION OF AGRICULTURAL MECHANISATION SERVICES IN MOZAMBIQUE

Eni Rovuma Basin B.V. – Mozambique Branch invites interested companies to submit expressions of interest for the Provision of Agricultural Mechanization Services for sunflower production in Mozambique during 2027–2028.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work consists of the provision, upon request by Eni Rovuma Basin B.V. – Mozambique Branch, of agricultural mechanisation services for sunflower production, including the following operations:

- Ploughing / primary land preparation
- Harrowing / secondary land and seedbed preparation
- Precision seeding of sunflower
- Fertiliser spreading
- Boom spraying
- Mechanical harvesting

All the above include the machinery or equipment, qualified operators, mechanics, supervision, spare parts, maintenance and operational support required for the assigned services.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AND INDICATIVE VOLUME

Indicative planning volume: approximately 3,000 ha across 6 Farms in 2027 and up to 5,000 ha across 8 Farms in 2028. The 2028 scope is optional and may be activated at Company discretion. Farm locations, areas and allocation of operations may be adjusted according to operational requirements.

Interested companies shall demonstrate relevant experience in agricultural mechanisation services of similar nature, scale and complexity, together with sufficient technical, operational and organisational capacity to execute the services safely and within the required seasonal timelines.

1. Companies should clearly identify the mechanised operation(s) for which they are expressing interest and demonstrate current access to suitable machinery, equipment and competent personnel for those operations.
2. Companies shall provide a realistic mobilisation approach demonstrating how the required machinery, operators, mechanics, spare parts and support resources will be made available in Mozambique for the applicable 2027–2028 agricultural seasons.

Where machinery or equipment is mobilised from outside Mozambique, the approach shall also demonstrate compliance with applicable cross-border, customs, temporary importation, transport, registration, insurance and road-safety requirements, including the necessary permits and documentation for lawful entry, movement, operation and subsequent re-export, where applicable.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

Companies interested in this invitation may submit their *Expression of Interest* by providing, through the below specified link, the following documentation:

I. Technical documents

- a) Evidence of relevant experience during the last five (5) years in providing agricultural mechanization services of similar nature and scale, including references of previous clients using the table below:

- b) Indicative machinery, personnel and mobilization capability declaration:

- i) A written declaration identifying the mechanization operation(s) offered and confirming current access to the corresponding machinery and equipment, together with the competent operators, mechanics and supervisors required.
- ii) A mobilization plan indicating how machinery, equipment, personnel, spare parts and maintenance support will be made available in Mozambique within the required seasonal timeframe.
- iii) A brief description of the company's operational support arrangements, including equipment maintenance, breakdown response, spare parts availability, backup/contingency capacity and machinery transport arrangements.

The declaration shall be supported, where applicable, by the following indicative evidence:

- iv) Machinery/equipment list by operation, including make, model, year, current location, ownership/lease/access status and indicative availability.
 - v) Ownership documents, lease agreements or equivalent evidence demonstrating access to the proposed machinery and equipment, together with operator/mechanic competency evidence where available.
- c) Brief documentary evidence demonstrating capability to meet HSE requirements, including relevant HSE procedures/records, training or competency records and equipment maintenance/inspection evidence.

II. Administrative documents

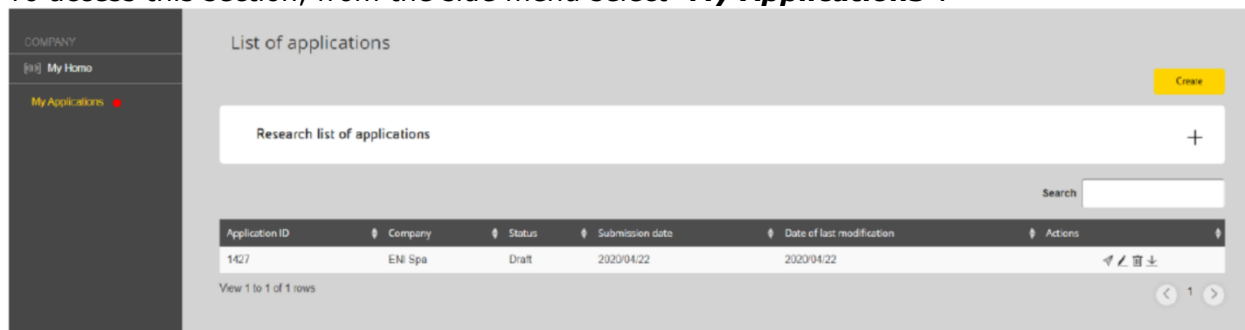
- a) Scanned certified copy of the Trade Register, Legal Entity name and contact person for receiving qualification package and other relevant information from the Company.
- b) Last three years Financial Statements and Annual Report including Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss and Cash Flow Statement. These documents must be provided for the Company Group (if applicable), and also for the Company's Mozambican registered entity that will enter into the subject contract.
- c) Company's registration in Mozambique. In case your Company is not already registered in Mozambique, please specify if you would be willing to promptly register in Mozambique and specify the respective timeline.
- d) Company and Group Structure with the list of major Shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in the stock exchange).
- e) In case you wish to participate in the *Expression of Interest* as a consortium or as a joint venture, information about each member of consortium or joint venture and role of each participant in the potential project. Such intention to form either a consortium or a JV, must be supported by an Agreement or "Memorandum of Understanding" duly signed by each entity in the group.
