



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR OFFSHORE AIR TRANSPORT SERVICES BY HELICOPTERS

Eni Rovuma Basin B.V., Mozambique Branch invites interested companies to submit their *Expression of Interest* for the provision of **AIR TRANSPORT SERVICES BY HELICOPTERS** to support operations in Mozambique.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work consists of provision of offshore Air Transportation Services by helicopters, as listed below:

- Commercial transportation of passengers and/or internal cargo of the Company, its Customers, its Agents, Contractors and Assignees within Company's concession areas, from/to Main Operating Base;
- Medical Evacuation, in order to facilitate emergency medical assistance, where immediate and rapid transportation is essential (e.g. Medical personnel or Company's injured personnel) according to Company's Emergency Response Plan;
- Limited SAR (Search And Rescue) only to provide air support to the Company's personnel who could be on distress or imminent danger inland or at the sea. For Limited SAR the helicopter shall equip with HERDS (Helicopter Emergency Rescue Deployment System) /air deployable linked raft or equivalent.

Service shall be provided by means of one (1), primary helicopter plus one (1) back-up unit, of same type/model, to replace the primary one being unserviceable or scheduled maintenance; the total of required helicopters are two (2) and shall be to the exclusive use of Company during the Contract period.

Operating Main Base (to be confirmed) will be Nampula Airport (FQNP/APL).

The Helicopters shall comply with the following characteristics:

- Multi engine helicopters;
- Certification Cat A/ Performance CP1 or alternatively, a specific approval from Civil Aviation Authority competent to the Contractor and/or to the area of operation for performance Class 2 with the use of exposure time;
- Passenger seating configuration approved for a minimum of 12 seats + 2 Pilots Crew;
- Certification basis: FAR / JAR / EASA CS 27 or 29;
- Capability to land on helideck with "t" value 10 ton, and "D" value 20 m;
 - In addition to their primary role, the aircrafts should feature quick conversion kits to carry medevac equipment, two stretchers, with approved (NCAA

(National Civil Aviation Authority) approval or STC (Supplement Type Certificate)) cabin configuration.

Helicopters will be required tentatively by end of Q2 2020 for a firm minimum contract duration of 2 (two) months, with, initially, possible extension options for further two periods of 2 (two) months each.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

Companies interested in this invitation may submit their *Expression of Interest* by providing the following mandatory information and documentation:

1. A valid Air Operator Certificate including operations approval for the type of services required;
2. Evidence of having a considerable experience in the offshore environment of operation involving helicopters compliant with the above listed characteristics;
3. Evidence of the Continuing Airworthiness and Maintenance Organization Approvals for the offered aircrafts;
4. Evidence of the Air Operator having in place and maintaining:
 - A Compliance monitoring / Quality System applied uniformly throughout the entire operation (to include flight operations and maintenance), to monitor compliance with, and the adequacy of, procedures required to ensure safe operational practices and continuing aircraft airworthiness;
 - An aviation oriented Safety Management System using a proactive and reactive management of safety, which shall interface with the Quality System.

Both systems shall be documented to ensure traceability, standardization and communication.

5. Any relevant references for the previously executed projects of similar technical characteristics and magnitude;
6. Scanned certified copy of the Trade Register, Legal Entity name and contact person for receiving qualification package and other relevant information from the Company;
7. Last three years Financial Statements and Annual Report including Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss and Cash Flow Statement. These documents must be provided for the Company Group (if applicable), and also for the Company's Mozambican registered entity that will enter into the subject contract;
8. Company's registration in Mozambique. In case your Company is not already registered in Mozambique, please specify if you would be willing to promptly register in Mozambique;
9. Company and Group Structure with the list of major Shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in the stock exchange);
10. Having Quality Management System certifications and/or certificates proving compliance with international Quality Standards (e.g. ISO 9001:2008);
11. Having Health & Safety Management System certification and/or documents proving compliance with international standards (ISO18001);

12. Any other information that will establish ability of fulfilling this scope of work.
