



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR PROVISION OF LONG-TERM VEHICLES RENTAL AND DRIVER SERVICES IN MOZAMBIQUE

Eni Rovuma Basin B.V. – Mozambique Branch invites interested companies to submit expressions of interest for the Provision of **Long-Term Vehicles Rental, Driver Services, Car Wash and Fuel provision at documented costs** in Mozambique.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work consists of provision of Long-Term Vehicles Rental, Driver Services, Car Wash and Fuel provision at documented costs as detailed below:

- Rental of vehicles (cars and buses) mainly but not limited to Maputo and Pemba, in Mozambique. Type of vehicles needed are SUVs, pick-ups double cabin full optional, minibuses (8 to 15 seats), light buses (16 to 25 seats), Sedan and SUV luxury cars;
- Driver Services;
- Vehicle maintenance services for all types of repair works including substitute vehicles;
- Supply of spare parts and consumables for all rented vehicles;
- Provision of vehicle washing services;
- Provision of fuel at documented costs for the rented vehicles.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AND VOLUME

The expected indicative volume, without minimum guaranteed quantities, is: 77 vehicles (cars); and 10 vehicles (buses).

Companies with a minimum of five (5) years of relevant operational experience may submit an Expression of Interest. Submissions will be accepted even if the full indicative vehicle volume is not immediately available, provided that the company:

1. Demonstrates current availability, including the total number of vehicles under its management (whether intended for direct use by Company), and provides a detailed plan showing capability to mobilize at least sixty percent (60%) of the required vehicles for each category by Q1 of 2027. This plan must outline the specific steps, milestones, and organizational measures that will be taken to achieve this threshold.
2. Submits a comprehensive mobilization plan outlining how and when the remaining vehicles will be delivered, including interim milestones and final completion dates.

The characteristic of the vehicles shall comply with the following minimum requirements:

- All vehicles should be preferably brand new (0 kilometres) or in any case not older than 2 years old (maximum of 20.000 kilometers for buses, 30.000 kilometres for cars) and shall be customized to the Company needs (IVMS (In Vehicle Monitoring System) or VDR (Vehicle Data Recorder); Panic Button; Isofix, etc.);
- Vehicles shall be fully compliant with Mozambican road traffic legislation, duly registered and authorised for circulation;
- Vehicles shall be structurally and mechanically compliant with manufacturer specifications, with no unauthorised modifications affecting safety;
- Vehicles shall be fitted with mandatory safety systems, including but not limited to:
 - Antilock Braking System (ABS) and Electronic Brake Distribution (EBD) braking systems;
 - Electronic Stability Control/Program (ESC/ESP) and Traction Control System (TCS);
 - Three-point seatbelts with pretensioners and seatbelt reminder systems;
 - Frontal (and side, where applicable) airbags for driver and passengers.
- Vehicles shall be equipped with air conditioning, functional instrumentation (speedometer, odometer) and legally compliant lighting systems;
- Vehicles shall be equipped with In-Vehicle Monitoring Systems (IVMS) where permitted by local legislation, capable of tracking mileage, speed, driving behaviour and safety events;
- Vehicles shall be covered by full comprehensive insurance in accordance with local laws;
- Vehicles shall be maintained in safe operating condition and supported by maintenance records and manufacturer documentation;
- Tyres, emergency equipment and on-board safety kits shall comply with minimum safety requirements.

In addition to the above vehicle requirements, interested companies shall demonstrate the availability of qualified professional drivers, compliant with local licensing and driving fitness requirements.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

Companies interested in this invitation may submit their *Expression of Interest* by providing, through the below specified link, the following documentation:

I. Technical documents:

- a) The evidence of experience in the last 5 years in the market providing similar SERVICE, and references of previous clients using the table below:

b) Indicative fleet availability declaration (EOI screening purpose):

- i) A written declaration confirming the current availability of the vehicles for each category (cars and buses), including evidence of full availability.
- ii) provide a detailed plan showing capability to mobilize at least sixty percent (60%) of the required vehicles for each category by Q1 of 2027. This plan must clearly outline how and in what steps the company will organize this mobilization; and
- iii) submit a detailed mobilization plan (e.g. timeline or Gantt chart) clearly indicating how and within what timeframe the remaining vehicles will be made available.

Such declaration shall be supported by the following indicative evidence:

- iv) fleet lists, including vehicle registration details and vehicle models;
 - v) lease agreements, ownership documentation, or equivalent declarations demonstrating availability of the vehicles;
- c) Documentary evidence demonstrating full compliance of the available/proposed vehicles with all minimum technical and safety requirements specified in the section above.

II. Administrative documents:

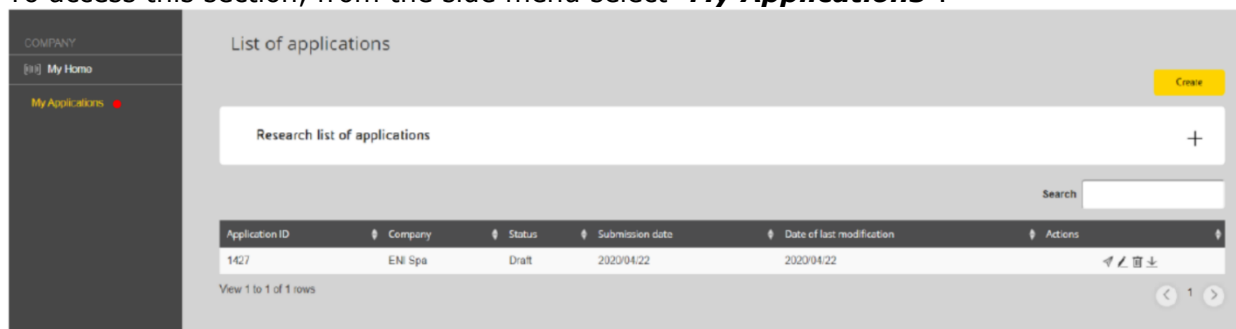
- a) Scanned certified copy of the Trade Register, Legal Entity name and contact person for receiving qualification package and other relevant information from the Company;
- b) Last three years Financial Statements and Annual Report including Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss and Cash Flow Statement. These documents must be provided for the Company Group (if applicable), and also for the Company's Mozambican registered entity that will enter into the subject contract;
- c) Company's registration in Mozambique. In case your Company is not already registered in Mozambique, please specify if you would be willing to promptly register in Mozambique and specify the respective timeline;
- d) Company and Group Structure with the list of major Shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in the stock exchange);
- e) In case you wish to participate in the *Expression of Interest* as a consortium or as a joint venture, information about each member of consortium or joint venture and role of each participant in the potential project. Such intention to form either a consortium or a JV, must be supported by an Agreement or "Memorandum of Understanding" duly signed by each entity in the group.
