



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES IN MOZAMBIQUE

Eni Rovuma basin B.V., Mozambique Branch – Upstream Delegated Operator, acting for and on behalf of Mozambique Rovuma Venture, Area 4 Operator, invites interested companies to submit expressions of interest for the provision of WASTE MANAGEMENT services in the Republic of Mozambique.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Operator's activities are located in the north of Mozambique both onshore and offshore. The main areas of interest (but not limited to) will be Pemba, Palma District and the offshore Area 4 in the Rovuma Basin located approximately 200 km northeast of Pemba City and 50 km from the coastline.

The main operations performed by the Operator in the north of Mozambique will be the offshore drilling and completion of wells, the installation of subsea infrastructures, the construction of onshore and near shore civil and industrial infrastructures, logistic operations and supporting activities.

Contractor's scope of work will consist of Waste Management Services to be executed in Mozambique in compliance with local regulations and Eni standards, in support of Operator's development projects onshore and offshore.

Contractor shall provide labor, supervision, licenses, warehousing, consumables, disposable materials, quality control associated with Waste Management services and be responsible for safety, security and environmental protection in accordance with the Scope of Work.

SERVICES MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

To submit its interest, Contractor shall demonstrate to be able to perform the following services:

- provide waste (hazardous and non-hazardous) collection from designated sites, stabilization, analysis, treatment, temporary storage and final disposal services in accordance with Operator HSE requirements and Local Regulations;
- transport waste in appropriate vehicles up to approved treatment and disposal facilities in accordance with Local Regulation and Operator requirements;
- assure that the treatment facilities, final disposal facilities are appropriate and authorized;
- temporarily store Operator's wastes (including mud/cuttings/wastewater) at a Contractor's base, when needed, in compliance with Local Regulation and Operator requirements;

- maximize recycling of Operator's waste over other disposal methods; perform laboratory analysis, when needed, for all the types of solid and liquid waste including muds, drill cuttings, wastewater and produced water from wells;
- provide equipment for waste collection and storage (i.e. containers, recycling bins, oil spill kit, tanks, ISO tanks, boxes, cutting skips etc.) suitable for the service (if and when required);
- Provide a management service of pre-treated drilling waste.
- Drilling residues to be considered under this category are:
 - spent Synthetic-Based Muds (SBMs)
 - spent Oil-Based Muds (OBMs)
 - spent Water-Based Muds (WBMs)
 - drill cuttings

The CONTRACTOR shall be qualified by the Ministry of Land, Environmental and Rural Development (MITADER1), for the above typology of SERVICES and shall perform them in full accordance to local and international laws and regulations.

DOCUMENTATIONS REQUIRED

2. Scanned Certified copy of the Trade Register, Legal Entity name and contact person for receiving qualification and commercial information;
3. Documented proof of experience in provision of Waste Management Services for Oil & Gas Industry in the last 5 years;
4. Documented professional references released by customers;
5. Documented evidences of authorizations, permits, licenses, certificates relating to waste management, transportation, storage, treatment, disposal inside and outside Mozambique;
6. Documented proof of experience in execution of Waste management Services in Africa and location of office in Mozambique;
7. Quality Management System certifications and/or certificates proving compliance with national or international Quality Standards (e.g. ISO 9001:2008);
8. Health, Safety & Environmental Management System certification and/or documents proving compliance with international standards(ISO 1400-2015 and OSHAS 18001 or ISO 45001-2018);
9. Latest balance sheet/Annual Report of the company registered in Mozambique and the latest consolidated balance sheet/Annual Report of the company group (if applicable).
10. Any other information that will establish that the company is a capable of fulfilling the scope of work.
